# 5.2 How to install this software (on Windows)

Turn on your computer and start Windows. Insert the CD-ROM supplied with this product into the CD-ROM drive. Then, double-click AutoRun.exe in the CD-ROM.

Select the model name and a language to use. Then, click the item to install ("USB Driver," "Operating Manual" or "Utility").

After the installer of the selected target is started, click the "Next" button according to the installer instructions and proceed through the installation process.

Open the Control Panel. Click "Uninstall a program" in the program menu.

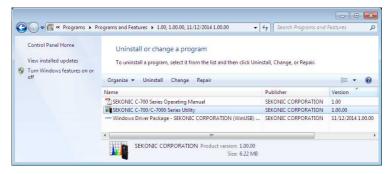


Figure 3 Uninstall a program

Turn on your Macintosh computer and start OS X. Insert the CD-ROM supplied with this product into the CD-ROM drive. Then, open the folder in the CD-ROM.

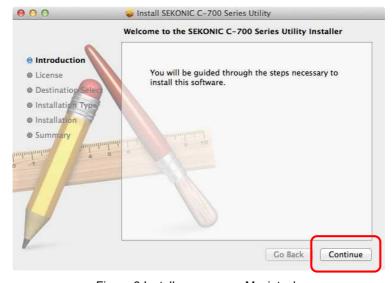


Figure 6 Installer screen on Macintosh

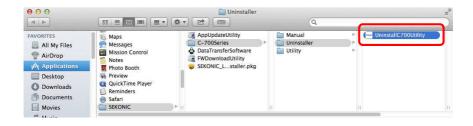


Figure 7 Application folder

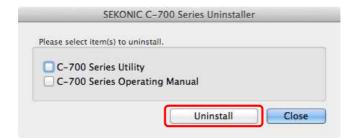


Figure 9 Uninstaller screen

If all items have been uninstalled and "UninstallC700Utility" has become unnecessary, open the "SEKONIC" folder in the "Application" folder, select the "C700Series" folder and drag and drop it into "Trash."

# Connecting to SPECTROMASTER

## 6.1 How to connect to SPECTROMASTER



Please prepare a USB cable before using this software.

USB cables are not supplied with this product.

Please use a USB A male to mini-B male cable.

- 1. Connect the USB cable to the computer.
- 2. Check that the power to SPECTROMASTER is turned off.
- 3. Connect the USB cable to SPECTROMASTER.
- 4. Turn on the power to SPECTROMASTER.
- Start this software.

When connection to SPECTROMASTER is completed, a screen as shown in Figure 10 appears.

- $\cdot$  If the process shown in Section 0 is not followed, communication errors may occur.
- · When this software is in operation, do not remove the USB cable with the SPECTROMASTER power turned on. Otherwise, the software may not work correctly even when the USB cable is reconnected.

If the USB cable is not connected correctly or if the SPECTROMASTER power is not

turned on, a screen as shown in Figure 11 appears.

In that case, check SPECTROMASTER and the connection of the USB cable.

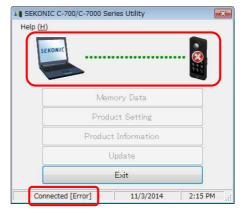


Figure 13 Connection status (error)

If SPECTROMASTER is in connection but in operation and error, screens as shown in Figure 12 to Figure 13 may appear. In that case, please refer to the SPECTROMASTER Operating Manual for actions to take.

If any of the screens shown in Figure 11 to 14 appears, or if a communication error has occurred, exit this software at once, reconnect the USB cable and restart this software according to the procedures shown in Section 0. ( Page 16)

## 6.2 How to disconnect from SPECTROMASTER

- 1. Exit this software.
- 2. Turn off the power to SPECTROMASTER.
- 3. Disconnect the USB cable connected to SPECTROMASTER.
- 4. Disconnect the USB cable connected to the computer.



Close the USB connection terminal cover on SPECTROMASTER properly after use.

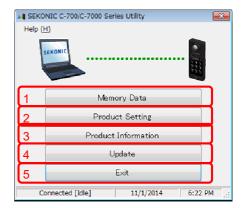


Figure 14 Main screen

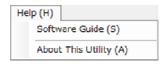


Figure 15 Menus (on Windows)

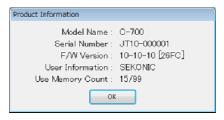


Figure 19 Product Information screen [C-700]

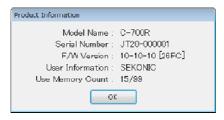


Figure 20 Product Information screen [C-700R]

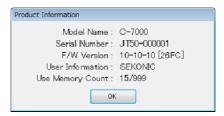


Figure 21 Product Information screen [C-7000]

# 7.3 Product Setting screen

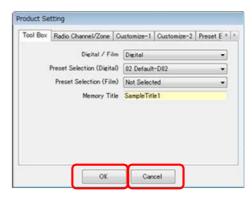


Figure 22 Product Setting screen

Clicking the "OK" button after changing any of the setting items sends all of the setting changes in a batch to SPECTROMASTER and brings you back to the main screen. Clicking the "Cancel" button does nothing but bring you back to the main screen. (Figure 22)

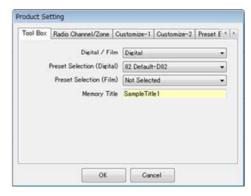


Figure 23 Product Setting / Tool Box

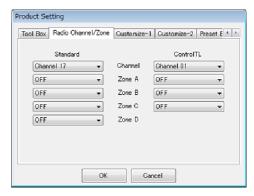


Figure 24 Product Setting / Radio Channel

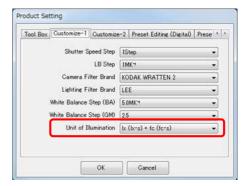


Figure 25 Product Setting / Customize-1

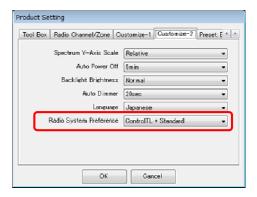


Figure 26 Product Setting / Customize-2

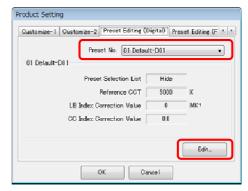


Figure 27 Product Setting / Preset Editing

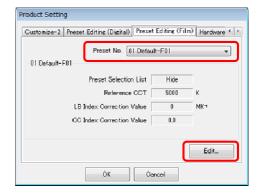


Figure 28 Product Setting / Preset Editing (Film)

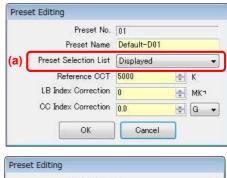




Figure 29 Product Setting / Preset Editing Dialog

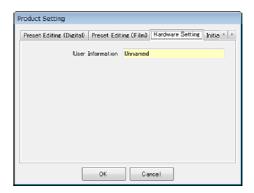


Figure 30 Product Setting / Hardware Setting

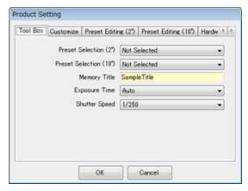


Figure 31 Product Setting / Tool Box

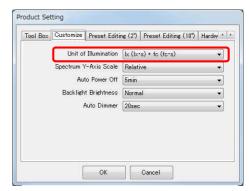


Figure 32 Product Setting / Customize

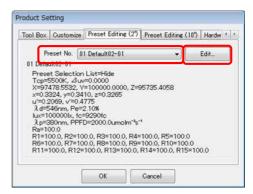


Figure 33 Product Setting / Preset Editing(2°)

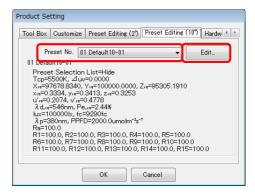


Figure 34 Product Setting / Preset Editing(10°)

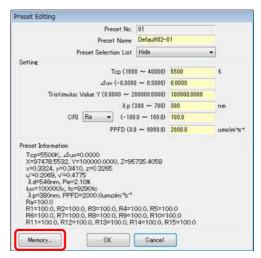


Figure 35 Preset Editing dialog

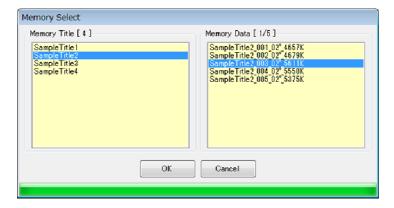


Figure 36 Preset Editing / Memory Select dialog

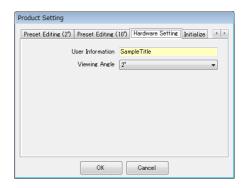


Figure 37 Product Setting / Hardware Setting

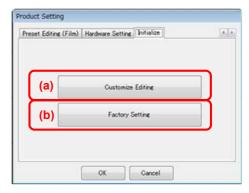


Figure 38 Product Setting / Initialize

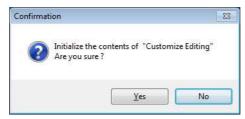


Figure 39 Confirmation screen the "Customize Editing"

#### 2. Contents of initialization executed by "Factory Setting"

All setting items of SPECTROMASTER are initialized to the factory default settings. The memory data are also initialized.

The "Confirmation" screen appears after clicking the "Factory Setting" button. Upon clicking the "Yes" button, the contents displayed on the Product Setting screen and values of each setting item for SPECTROMASTER are initialized.

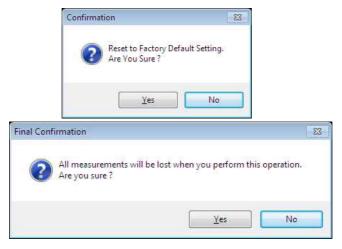


Figure 40 Confirmation screen the "Factory Setting"



Once clicking the "Yes" button on each Confirmation screen to initialize, it is impossible to return to the previous setting even if clicking the "Cancel" button on the Setting screen.

## 7.4 Memory Data Management screen

The Memory Data Management screen is used to save measurement data held by SPECTROMASTER as files and to display (preview) and delete the measurement data. Besides saving data as CSV files, various graphs can be saved as image files. Graphs to be displayed and graphs that can be saved as files vary with the connected model.

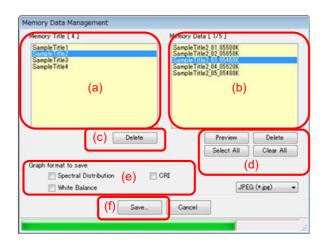


Figure 41 Memory Data Management [C-700/C-700R]

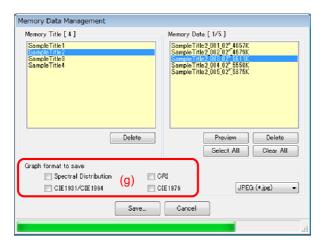


Figure 42 Memory Data Management [C-7000]

To manage (save, display or delete) memory data in SPECTROMASTER, select a relevant memory title from "Memory Title" shown with (a) so that all memory data that belong under the selected memory title are displayed in "Memory Data" shown with (b).

## 1. "Delete" a memory title

By selecting an item in "Memory Title" and clicking the "Delete" button shown with (c), the selected memory title and all memory data related to the selected title are deleted.

## 2. "Preview" memory data

By selecting an item in "Memory Data" and clicking the "Preview" button shown with (d), contents of the selected memory data are displayed on the "7.5 Preview screen" ( Page 39). When multiple items in the list are selected, the "Preview" button cannot be clicked.

## 3. "Delete" memory data

By selecting an item in "Memory Data" and clicking the "Delete" button shown with (d), the selected memory data are deleted. When multiple items in the list are selected, the "Delete" button cannot be clicked.

### 4. "Select All" memory data

By clicking the "Select All" button shown with (d), all items in "Memory Data" are selected.

## 5. "Clear All" memory data

By clicking the "Clear All" button shown with (d), the selection of all items in "Memory Data" is cleared.

## 6. "Save" memory data

By selecting item(s) (multiple selections allowed) in "Memory Data" and clicking the "Save" button shown with (f), the selected memory data are saved in a file. If a file of the same name already exists, the existing file is overwritten.

The memory data are saved in the CSV format. If item(s) shown with (e) in Figure 41 or item(s) shown with (g) in Figure 42 have check mark(s), relevant graph image(s) are saved. The names of files to be saved are shown in "Table 5 File names of memory data to be saved."

## 7.5.1 Menus

The following menus are provided for each Preview format and are used to save graphs individually:

1. Save as

Saves graph images in files.

2. Copy to clipboard

Copies graph images to a clipboard.

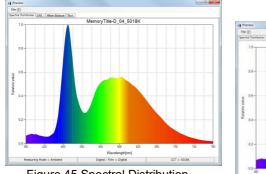


Figure 43 Preview screen / Menus (on Windows)

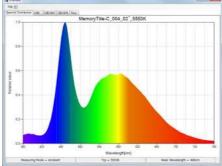


Figure 45 Spectral Distribution

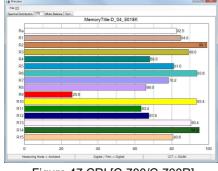

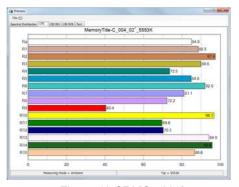


Figure 47 CRI [C-700/C-700R]

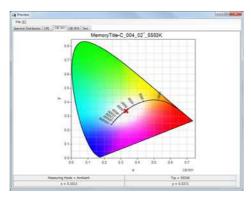


Figure 50 CIE1931Chromaticity Diagram [C-7000]

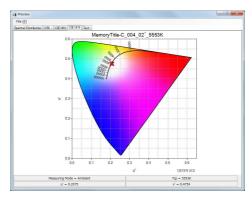


Figure 51 CIE1976 Chromaticity Diagram [C-7000]

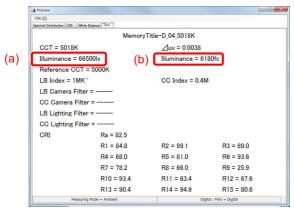


Figure 52 Text [C-700/C-700R]

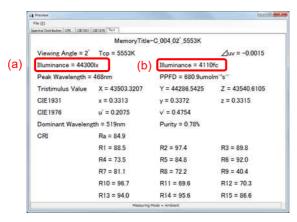


Figure 53 Text [C-7000]

By clicking the "Next >" button on the "Update-1" screen, the acquisition of the update information is started.

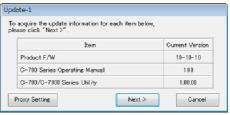


Figure 54 Update-1 [C-700/C-700R]

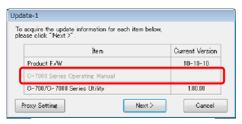


Figure 55 Update-1 [C-7000]

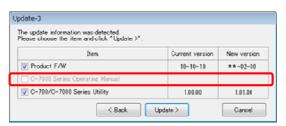


Figure 58 Update-3 [C-7000]

#### 4. Update-4

The update information is acquired and the update is performed sequentially for the items that are checked on the "Update-3" screen.

An ongoing acquisition process of the update information can be cancelled by clicking the "Cancel" button.

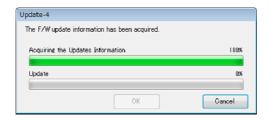


Figure 59 Update-4 (The F/W update information has been acquired)

During the update of the SPECTROMASTER F/W, do not turn off the power to SPECTROMASTER or remove the USB cable. Otherwise, SPECTROMASTER may not work correctly.

After the update of the SPECTROMASTER F/W is completed, the meter is automatically turned off. Turn on the power of SPECTROMASTER to check the status.

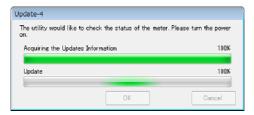


Figure 61 Update-4 (Update)

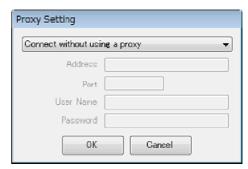


Figure 63 Proxy Setting-1

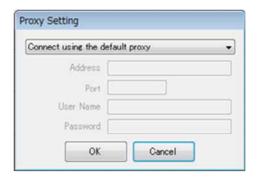


Figure 64 Proxy Setting-2

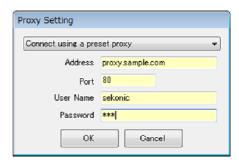


Figure 65 Proxy Setting-3
